



Technical Notification 200

Re: Pairs Tests – Minimum scores needed to achieve test credit for IJS Protocol in nonqualifying competitions, for pairs tests.

Implementation Date: November 1, 2017

In accordance with Rules TR 3.00, TR 4.00, TR 4.01 and TR 4.02, which go into effect November 1, 2017, in order to be eligible to apply for test credit through an IJS protocol, candidates must meet the following minimum scores at a nonqualifying competition:

Juvenile Pairs Free Skate:

Minimum TES: 9.00

Minimum PCS: 12.00

Minimum TSS: 21.00

Intermediate Pairs Free Skate:

Minimum TES: 11.20

Minimum PCS: 17.00

Minimum TSS: 28.20

Novice Pairs Free Skate:

Minimum TES: 14.60

Minimum PCS: 24.00

Minimum TSS: 38.60

Junior Pairs Free Skate:

Minimum TES: 20.90

Minimum PCS: 28.00

Minimum TSS: 48.90

Senior Pairs Free Skate:

Minimum TES: 23.40

Minimum PCS: 32.00

Minimum TSS: 55.40

Note that the candidate must meet all three minimum scores for the level they wish to pass, in addition to having each element receive a score of > 0 total points. (A disqualifying "0 value" element will be noted on the protocol with the symbol " - - - " in lieu of a GOE or points awarded.)
