Trial judges are not required to have a skating background; however, trial judges who have passed a minimum level of test, achieved certain competitive accomplishments and/or earned a coaching accreditation will qualify for a "fast track" at the accelerated or advanced level.

Trial judges may trial any test regardless of the track in which they are registered.

Those already named to the accelerated or advanced track based on previous criteria will remain in those tracks. Those previously named to the select track will be in the advanced track.

Trial judges who pass higher-level tests, earn a higher-level coach accreditation and/or who compete for the first time in one of the required competition events after beginning to trial judge may apply for promotion to a higher track here:
