



## ***Technical Notification 311***

**Dated: Oct. 24, 2024**

**Re: Synchronized – Collegiate Division – Minimum Test Qualifications**

The Board of Directors approved expanding the minimum test qualifications for the collegiate division to include the adult gold skating skills test or higher.

In support of this change, Rule 9400 was amended as follows:

**9400 Synchronized Skating Test Qualifications and Age Requirements**

Test qualifications are as of the closing date for entries. Age requirements are as of the preceding July 1.

<b>Competitive Level</b>	<b>Minimum Test Qualifications</b> <i>Tests may be standard or Skate United unless otherwise noted. Pattern dance tests may be partnered or solo.</i>	<b>Age Requirements</b>
Collegiate	Bronze skating skills or higher or the bronze pattern dance test or higher <u>or the adult gold skating skills test or higher</u>	12-20 skaters, all of whom must have a high school diploma or equivalent and be enrolled in a degree program at a college or university and must be full-time students as recognized by the college or university they attend
