


Overview:

There are opportunities to volunteer on January 26 - 30 in a variety of ways such as registration, locker rooms, ticket sales, ushers, guard runners, team services and more. There are shifts in the morning, afternoon and evening and each shift is approximately 6 hours. (See below for details).

Benefits of Volunteering:

- First and foremost, we are involved in a sport that is run by volunteers - none of these events happen without us. Volunteers are often surprised at how much fun it is to see what happens behind the scenes and to work alongside fellow skaters.
- Tickets! You will receive a wristband for entry on the day you volunteer (for the times that day when you are not volunteering) as well as an additional wristband for the day of your choice.
- Free (and reserved!) parking at 750 University Ave for the day of your shift(s).
- Those who work consecutive shifts on the same day will have a meal break and meal included.

How to Sign Up to Volunteer:



1) Sign in to www.usfsaonline.org.

If you are NOT a USFS member, create a free account so you can volunteer - please do NOT use your child's or spouse's account to sign up.

2) Click on "Volunteer Opportunities" in the upper right corner and select "2022 Eastern Synchronized Skating Sectional Championships." Follow the prompts to complete your registration.

After you register, you will receive an email with further instructions on how to select which shifts and positions you are interested in volunteering.

Volunteer Orientation (SAVE THE DATE!): Two 30-minute Zoom volunteer orientation sessions will take place on Tuesday, January 18 at 7:00pm and Wednesday, January 19, at 6:00 pm. We ask that you attend one of these sessions to learn more about volunteer expectations and your position.

COVID-19 Protocols (US Figure Skating Requirements): All Volunteers MUST produce a negative PCR (molecular) test OR a NAAT (nucleic acid amplification test) within 3 days prior to first arrival at the competition*. Other test types – such as rapid antigen tests - will not be accepted. The following information must be visible (and if possible highlighted, example may be found [HERE](#)) on the result being provided at the time of credential/ticket pick-up: person's name, date test was taken, result indicating "negative" or "not detected", and type of test taken.
